

9190 DISTRICT - COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

The Board of Education respects the contributions to community life made by local businesses, post-secondary institutions of higher learning, community organizations, and other community groups that enrich the educational potential of the overall community through a sharing of knowledge and resources.

The Board directs the Superintendent to be aware of opportunities for an expanded educational program enriched through community partnership. Community and district partnerships shall focus on the implementation of student opportunities for employment, workplace readiness training, post-secondary education, career exploration, and other programs that expand and enrich the instructional program by drawing upon the diversity and availability of community resources. The Superintendent shall determine those schools, instructional programs, and/or district operations that would benefit from involvement of appropriate community partnerships.

The Superintendent shall direct each building principal to follow standard and efficient protocols through regulation for seeking approval of community and district partnerships. The Superintendent shall maintain a file of all community and district partnerships involved in the instructional program of the district and shall direct the maintenance of annual evaluation and modifications of the community resource file, as necessary.
